

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACT, 1934.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Unemployment Assistance Board after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon it by Section 52 (1) of the Unemployment Assistance Act, 1934, to make Rules:—

(1) prescribing the manner of application for a decision under Section 36 (3) of the Act:

(2) prescribing the manner of application for an allowance and of registration for employment:

(3) as to the manner in which a person shall prove the matters specified in Sections 38 (1) and 43 of the Act.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Unemployment Assistance Board has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made The Unemployment Assistance (Allowances) Provisional Rules, 1934, to come into force as Provisional Rules on confirmation by the Minister of Labour and to continue in force until Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
