along the road via Bardsley, Oldham, Royton and Balderstone to Rochdale; thence in a general north-easterly direction via Smallbridge, Dearnley, Littleborough, Warland, Walsden, Todmorden, and Eastwood to Hebden Bridge; thence in a general south-easterly direction along the road via Mytholmroyd, Luddenden Foot, Sowerby Bridge and Copley to Elland Railway Station; thence in an easterly direction along the London, Midland and Scottish Railway via Brighouse and Bradley to its junction with the line from Huddersfield to Highburton at Deighton Station; thence continuing in a southerly direction along the Highburton branch line via Fenay Bridge to Highburton Station; thence in a general south-easterly direction along the road from Huddersfield via Shelley Far Bank; Shepley, Park Head, Ingbirchworth and Penistone, to Penistone railway station, and thence along the London and North Eastern Railway via Wortley Station to Deepcar Station and the point of commencement.
