The KING having been graciously pleased to ordain and declare that Michael Thomas Henderson, Captain 16th/5th Lancers, Roderic Harold Dalzell Henderson, and Margaret Violet, wife of Henry Charles Minshull Stockdale, younger sons and daughter of Harold Greenwood Henderson (commonly called the Honourable Harold Greenwood Henderson), Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, shall henceforth have, hold and enjoy the same title, rank, place, pre-eminence and precedence as the younger sons and daughter of a Baron as would have been due to them had their father, the said Harold Greenwood Henderson, survived his father, Alexander, Baron Faringdon, and had thereby succeeded to the title and dignity of Baron Faringdon.

And to Command that the said Order and Declaration be registered in His Majesty's College of Arms.
