##### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

##### CHESHIRE RIVERS CATCHMENT AREA.

##### CHESHIRE RIVERS CATCHMENT BOARD.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has prepared a draft

Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, combining the West Cheshire Rivers Catchment Area and the River Weaver Catchment Area as one Catchment Area, to be known as the Cheshire Rivers Catchment Area, constituting the drainage board of the combined area and dissolving the River Weaver Catchment Board.

A copy of the map has been deposited for public inspection with the draft Order referred to above.
