Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,\* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation.
