Fruit Tree Pests (Kent) Order of 1934.

This Order empowers officers appointed by the Local Authorities for the County of Kent, the City and County Borough of Canterbury, the City of Rochester, the Boroughs of Chatham, Folkestone, Gillingham (Kent), Gravesend, Maidstone, Margate, Ramsgate and Tunbridge Wells to investigate complaints from fruit growers that fruit trees growing on other premises are likely to cause the spread to their own trees of certain scheduled diseases and pests, and enables the Local Authority to take action to prevent the spread of infection.
