WHEREAS by Section 37 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act, 1932, it is enacted that His Majesty, if satisfied that the Government of any country has acceded to the Safety Convention, may, by Order in Council, make a declaration to that effect:

HEREAS by Section 107 of the Companies Act, 1929 (19 and 20 Geo. 5. c. 23) it is, amongst other things, provided that:

(1) If by virtue of the law in force in any part of His Majesty's Dominions outside Great Britain Companies incorporated under that law have power to keep in Great Britain Branch Registers of their members resident in Great Britain His Majesty may, by Order in Council, direct that Sections 98 and 100 of the said Act shall subject to any modifications and adaptations specified in the Order apply to and in relation to any such Branch Registers kept in Great Britain as they apply to
