

are satisfied that the application of the aforesaid provisions of Article 2 (a) to goods manufactured prior to the twenty-ninth day of June, 1935, and imported before the first day of October, 1935, is likely to cause hardship to the said persons;

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Section 3, hereby direct as follows:—

1. Until the first day of October, 1935, paragraph (a) of Article 2 of the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) No. 3 Order, 1935, shall not apply to flooring blocks and strips which were manufactured prior to the twenty-ninth day of June, 1935, provided that such goods bear an indication of origin stamped, stencilled, printed, impressed or incised on one of the larger surfaces of each block or strip.

2. This Direction may be cited as the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 3) 1935.
