

NORTHERN IRELAND LAND ACT, 1925.

Pursuant to rule 4 of the Northern Ireland Land (Finance) Rules, 1926, relating to the drawing of Guaranteed $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. Bonds issued under the Northern Ireland Land Act, 1925, the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that the sum of £27,380 has been certified by the National Debt Commissioners to be available for the next drawing of these bonds, in accordance with the Certificate contained in the Schedule hereto, and that the next drawing of these bonds will take place on the 20th August, 1935.

A list of the bonds drawn will be published in the London Gazette as soon afterwards as possible and in any case not later than the 1st September, 1935.
