The Regulations, which may be cited as the Coal Mines (Rescue) Amending Regulations, 1935, come into force as follows:-

Regulation 1, dealing with reviving apparatus required to be kept at Central Rescue Stations, on 1st August, 1935.

Regulation 2, dealing with reviving apparatus required to be kept at mines employing 100 or more persons underground, on 1st January, 1936.
