RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations amending the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations, 1931, in connection with the construction and use of track laying vehicles.
