Genova, August 9. N. S.

THE Centurion Man of War, Capt. Price Commander, which arrived here some time ago from *Ostend*, failed on the 22th of the last month for *Alicant* and *Cadiz*. On the 2d Instant the Bailly of *Noailles* came into this Port with 20 French Gallies, and soon after his arrival the Senate sent two Noblemen to Compliment him, which he returned by one of his chief Officers. The Duke of *Turfs* went also and paid him a Visit, which the Bailly of *Noailles* returned the same day; and on the 5th Instant he sailed hence for *Legborne*. Yesterday the Gallies of *Turfs* set sail for *Naples*. There has lately happened some Difference between this Republick and the Great Duke of *Tuscany* about the Limits of their respective Dominions, upon which the Duke of *Parma* having offered his Mediation, the Republick has sent Signior *Gritto* to *Parma*, to adjust that Affair with the Minister whom the Duke of *Tuscany* is likewise sending thither.

Legborne, Aug. 11. On the 7th Instant 20 French Gallies under the Command of the Bailly of *Noailles*, came in here from *Marseilles*, but last from *Genova*; and the next day they sailed again for *Civita-Vecchia* and the Coast of *Naples*. This day arrived here from *Galispoli* an English Merchant Ship commanded by Capt. *William Arthur*. The *Legborne* Galley is Lading here, and will shortly sail for *London*.

Warsaw, Aug. 15. We have received an Account, that the King of *Poland* came on the 7th Instant to *Seberseczin*, and intended to be this day at *Lemberg*, at which place he is to have a meeting with the Czar, who it's believed is already arrived there. The Army of the Crown is encamped at *Monasterzick*, and the King's German Troops are marching to *Halietz*, which is appointed for their Rendezvous, and 'tis expected that by the end of this month they will be all joined together. It is yet uncertain whether the King will besiege *Caminiack*, or march first into *Moldavia* and *Walachia*; which Provinces have made several Steps towards putting themselves under the Protection of this Crown. The Turks make all the Provision they can for the Defence of *Caminiack*, and we hear a great Body of Tartars are lately come from *Budziack* and the Parts adjacent, and are encamped near that place.

Vienna, Aug. 16. The Emperor's Ministers have been several times in Conference upon the Business about which my Lord *Pager's* Secretary is come hither, and it is said they will dispatch him back in a few days, with such an Answer to the Message he brought from the Grand Signior as will in all likelihood much advance the Negotiation for a Peace. Admiral *Assenbergh* has lately received several Sums of Money for the Service of the Emperor's Fleet on the *Danube*, and designs in a day or two to go hence for *Peterwaradin*, towards which place the 6 Vessels lately built here are ordered to repair with all expedition that they may join the rest of the Fleet, which are already there. Divers Barks laden with Provisions

and Ammunition were this week sent down the *Danube* for the Service of the Emperor's Forces in *Hungary*. Our Letters from thence of the 9th Instant advise, that the Imperial Army encamped the 7th near *Batsch*, where they continued the 8th; The 9th they marched again, and the Foot incamped near *Bukin*, and the Horse over-against *Illock*, where Prince *Eugene* had his Head Quarters. These Advices add, that the Aga of the Janizaries was daily expected at *Belgrade* with part of the Turkish Army, and that the Grand Visier followed with the rest of their Forces. We have an account from *Slavonia*, that a Party of Germans having taken several Prisoners, and some Cattle near the Castle of *Ostrosac*, the Turks sent out a Party in order to recover the Booty, but came too late; after which the Enemy attacked the Castle of *Novi*, and were repulsed.

Francfort, Aug. 24. The Elector *Palatine* came the 19th Instant to *Weynheim*, and several of the Neighbouring Princes have sent their Ministers thither to Compliment him on his arrival in the *Palatinate*. It is believed his Electoral Highness will go in a short time to *Darmstadt* to Visit the Landgrave of *Darmstadt*, and that afterwards he will come to this Place, and from hence will return to *Dufeldorp*. We hear the demolishing of Bridge near *Brisac* is almost finished, and that that Town will be evacuated by the French in a few days. The Elector of *Mentz* is expected back at *Mentz* this day from *Aschaffembourg*. The Landgrave *William* of *Hesse-Rhinfls* passed by that place some days ago in his way to *Rhinfls*. They write from *Lorraine*, that the French have made an end of dismantling the City of *Nancy*, pursuant to the Treaty of *Ryswick*, and their Troops are preparing to march from thence.

Brussels, Aug. 28. The Deputies from the States of the several Provinces of the *Spanish-Netherlands* continue to Confer with the Ministers of this Court about the Supplies which are demanded of them for Maintaining the Forces to be kept on foot for the Defence of these Provinces. The Baron of *Chauvire*, Envoy Extraordinary from the Duke of *Lorraine*, had Audience of his Electoral Highness some days ago, and is gone with the like Character to the Courts of *Spain* and *Portugal*. We hear from *Lisle*, that the French are making a new Work to cover one of the Gates of that City, which they call the Gate of *Menin*, and are making some other alterations in the Fortifications there.

Dieren, Aug. 29. His Majesty came hither on Monday night, and designs to continue at this place till Saturday. The Count *d'Arvergne* is still at Court, but designs to return to *France* in a few days.

Hague, Aug. 29. N. S. Deputies are lately arrived here from the Provinces of *Guelderland* and *Utrecht*, who have since been in Conference with those of the States-General about some Proposals for making the Rivers of *Issel* and the *Lower-Rhine* Navigable. The States have agreed to lend a considerable Sum of Money to the Crown of *Spain* for supplying the Frontier Places in the
