

CHILLED BEEF.

1. The provisions of Article 3 of the said Order requiring an indication of origin on importation shall apply to chilled beef imported from the Union of South Africa subject to this modification, that is to say, the indication of origin may be applied by means of the three words

placed vertically one beneath the other in a continuous series of words in three columns in the positions specified in the said Paragraph I of Article 3 of the said Order.

FROZEN PORK.

2. The provisions of Paragraph IV of Article 3 and Paragraph I of Article 4 of the said Order shall not apply to loins and shoulder cuts of frozen pork from which the skin has been removed prior to importation; and

3. The provisions of Paragraph V of Article 3 and Paragraph II of Article 4 of the said Order shall apply to such meat as though the descriptions "loins of frozen pork from which the skin has been removed prior to importation" and "shoulder cuts of frozen pork from which the skin has been removed prior to importation" had been added to the forms of meat specified in these paragraphs.

GENERAL.

4. This Direction may be cited as the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 4), 1935, and shall come into operation on the 31st October, 1935. The Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 4), 1934, the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 7), 1934, and the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 1), 1935, shall be withdrawn as from the date on which this Direction takes effect.
