The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Corpus Christi College, Cambridge, on the 15th day of November, 1935, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

STATUTE TO ALTER AND AMEND THE STATUTES OF CORPUS CHRISTI COLLEGE IN THE UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE, WHICH AMENDING STATUTE, HAVING BEEN DULY MADE AT A MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE SAID COLLEGE, SPECIALLY SUMMONED FOR THE PURPOSE AND HELD ON THE 15TH NOVEMBER, 1935, AND PASSED AT SUCH MEETING BY THE VOTES OF NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE NUMBER OF PERSONS PRESENT AND VOTING, AND NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED AMENDING STATUTE HAVING BEEN GIVEN TO THE UNIVERSITY, IS NOW SUBMITTED FOR THE APPROVAL OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING IN COUNCIL.

We, the Master and Fellows of Corpus Christi College in the University of Cambridge, do hereby in pursuance of the power
