NOTICE TO BONDHOLDERS.

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the power reserved to Them by the Prospectus dated the twenty-ninth day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, and of the Treasury Regulations made thereunder, the within-mentioned Bonds, amounting to forty-four million pounds, were this day drawn for repayment.

The Bonds will be paid off at par at the Bank of England on or after the 15th April, 1936. When presented for payment they must be accompanied by all Coupons bearing date subsequent to the 15th April, 1936, from which date interest on the Bonds will cease.
