(2) The Sibsey Rural District shall be added to and form part of the Stickney sub-district.

(3) That part of the parish of Wildmore which, prior to the operation of the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Holland and Lindsey) Act, 1935, constituted the parish of Copping Syke shall be added to and form part of the Tattershall sub-district.

5. The superintendent registrars of the existing Wisbech, Spilsby and Horncastle districts shall respectively be the superintendent registrars of those districts as extended by this Order.

6. The registrars of the existing Leverington, Stickney and Tattershall sub-districts shall respectively be the registrars of those sub-districts as extended by this Order.

7. The functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the area united with the Wisbech district by Article 2 of this Order are hereby transferred to the Council of the Administrative County of the Isle of Ely, and in relation to the area united with the Spilsby and Horncastle districts by Article 3 (1) of this Order to the Council of the Administrative County of the Parts of Lindsey, Lincolnshire.

ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL  
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 9th December, 1935.)

No. 26/1935.

Whereas the Superintendent Registrar's district of Machynlleth is situate partly within and partly without the Administrative County of Montgomery;

And whereas the part without the said County will, on the 1st day of January, 1936, in consequence of and by virtue of the Montgomeryshire Registration Scheme, 1935, made by the Council of the Administrative County of Montgomery and approved by the Minister of Health under Section 24 of the Local Government Act, 1929, become a separate Superintendent Registrar's district;

And whereas it is expedient that on the formation of the separate Superintendent Registrar's district as aforesaid provision should be made for its union with the Superintendent Registrar's district of Aberystwyth and for the extension of the Geneurglynn sub-district;

And whereas it is necessary to transfer the functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the part of the Superintendent Registrar's district of Machynlleth which is situate without the Administrative County of Montgomery;

Now, therefore, the Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in

exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 10 and 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1937, Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, Section 21 (2) of the Local Government Act, 1929, and of all other powers in that behalf, with the approval and sanction of the Minister of Health, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Counties of Cardigan and Montgomery Registration of Births, etc., Order, 1935, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1936.

(2) In this Order the term "district" means a Superintendent Registrar's district, and the terms "existing district" and "existing sub-district" mean respectively a district and a sub-district which existed immediately before the 1st day of January, 1936.

2. That portion of the existing Machynlleth district which will, on the 1st day of January, 1936, become a separate district situate wholly without the Administrative County of Montgomery shall be united with the existing district of Aberystwyth into one district which shall be called the Aberystwyth district.

3. The existing Geneurglynn sub-district shall be extended by the addition of that portion of the existing Machynlleth sub-district situate without the Administrative County of Montgomery.

4. The Superintendent Registrar of the existing Aberystwyth district shall be the Superintendent Registrar of the Aberystwyth district as constituted by this Order.

5. The Registrar of Births and Deaths of the existing Geneurglynn sub-district shall be the Registrar of Births and Deaths of the Geneurglynn sub-district as extended by this Order.

6. The functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the part of the existing Machynlleth district which is situate without the Administrative County of Montgomery are hereby transferred to the Council of the Administrative County of Cardigan.
