Thence along the road in a north-easterly direction past the Hangers to the village of Corhampton at the junction of Corhampton Lane with the Alton-Farnham road.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence along the road running in a northeasterly direction through Warnford and West Meon crossing the Meon Valley Railway at Privett Station to near Colemore, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 180 square miles situated in the Counties of Southampton, Surrey and Sussex.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at the intersection of South Street and West Street in the village of Billingshurst situated in Sussex, thence along West Street in a westerly direction crossing the River Arun at New Bridge, through Wisborough Green, thence along the road in a north-westerly and westerly direction, past Barkfold House to the cross-roads at Kirdford, thence along the road running in a northwesterly and north-easterly direction, past Great Common and Mackerel's Common, thence in a north-westerly and westerly direction through Plaistow and past Eastend Farm, Shillinglee Park and Newhouse Farm, to the cross-roads near Fisher Street. Thence along the road in a north-westerly direction past Broadlands to the County Boundary at Cripplecrutch Hill. Thence in a westerly direction past Ansteadbrook and Lythe Hill and in a northerly direction past Holdfast Farm to the cross-roads at Manor House situated about 2,200 feet west of Imbhams Farm, thence in a westerly and south-westerly direction past Grayswood Beeches and crossing the Southern Railway near St. Bartholomew's Church to Derby Road on the outskirts of Haslemere, in the County of Surrey. Thence in a southwesterly direction along Derby Road and Weydown Road and in a westerly direction past Shottermill, thence in a north-westerly direction past Wolmer Hill and Pitfold House to the main Godalming-Petersfield road by Chase Villas. Thence in a south-westerly direction along the said main road over Bramshott Common to Cold Ash Hill, thence in a northwesterly direction to the village of Bramshott in the county of Southampton, passing through Bramshott by way of St. Mary's Church, Covar's Farm and Bramshott Mill, thence in a westerly direction along the road past the Mill House, crossing the River Way and in a north-westerly direction over Passfield Common to the road junction at Eveley House by the Ford at Standford. Thence along the road in a south-westerly direction past the smithy and Hollywater, thence in a westerly direction past White Hill, and in a south-westerly direction past Blackmoor, Snap Wood, Brockbridge Farm and Bradshott Hall and in a north-westerly direction to the fork-roads by Ketcher's Farm near Selborne. Thence along the road running in a south-westerly direction along Galley Hill past Selborne Common, Lower Noar Hill Farm and Old Place Farm to the cross-roads in the village of East Tisted.

Western Boundary.

Thence along the main road in a southwesterly direction past Oak Wood and Privett Station and continuing along the road to the cross-roads in West Meon, situated about 700 feet west of the house known as Elm Croft.

Southern Boundary.

Thence along the road running in an easterly and south-easterly direction past Riplington, and Drayton through East Meon by way of All Saints' Church and Rookham Lodge to the junction of roads by Pidham Cottage situated about 1,000 feet south of Langrish House. Thence along the road in a south-easterly direction past Barrow Hill, Ramsdean, Twentyways Farm, thence in an easterly direction crossing the Southern Railway and in a south-easterly direction to the village of Buriton. Thence in a south-easterly direction along Oldway Lane, through Cockshot Wood and the road skirting the south edge of the Miscombe to the terminus of the road by the old chalk pit situated about 1,100 feet north of Sunwood Farm. Thence in a northerly direction to the fork-roads about 1,500 feet south of Old Ditcham and along the road in a north-easterly direction to the junction of roads about 1,300 feet east of Old Ditcham. Thence along the road in a south-easterly direction through South Harting in Sussex to Turkey Island, thence in a north-easterly direction through East Harting, thence along the road in an easterly direction to the cross-roads at Elsted, and in a southerly direction to Redlands, thence in an easterly direction past St. Peter's Church to the road junction, thence in a southerly direction through Treyford and in an easterly direction through Didling past Linch Farm and Bepton to the cross-roads in the village of Cocking. Thence along the main Midhurst Road in a north-westerly direction past Oldhouse Farm, Cocking Park and West Lavington to the road junction near Balls Farm, thence in a westerly direction along the road past Great Todham Farm, and South Ambersham to the cross-roads at Selham. Thence in a northerly direction along the road crossing the River Rother by Lods Bridge to Beggars' Corner situated by the mill at Halfway Bridge, thence in an easterly direction along the road past White House, Little Common and Tillington to Petworth, passing through Petworth by way of Pound Street, Park Road, Church Street, East Street and Angel Street.

Thence in a south-easterly direction along the road past Byworth, Low Heath, Egdean, through Fittleworth and past Stopham and Coldharbour to the cross-roads in the village of Pulborough.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence along London Road in a northeasterly direction past Codmore Hill and along Stane Street to Billingshurst, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 166 square miles situated in the County of Sussex.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing from the road junction about 250 feet south of St. Mary's Church in the village of Fittleworth, thence along the road
