The Board of Trade hereby give notice that they have received during the month of December, 1935, a Report of a *Naval Court* held at Manila into the circumstances attending the stranding and total loss of the M.V. "Silverhazel" at San Bernardino Island, Philippine Islands, on the 9th November, 1935.

Captain Harry Crookshank, M.P., Secretary for Mines, has appointed Mr. Leo Cyril Aloysius Benson to be a Junior Inspector of Mines under the Coal Mines Acts, 1887 to 1919, and has instructed him to act also as an Inspector for the purposes of the Metalliferous Mines Regulation Acts, 1872 and 1875, and of the Quarries Act, 1894.
