At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 3rd day of October, 1935.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS by the Nigeria Protectorate Order in Council, 1922, as amended by the Nigeria Protectorate Order in Council, 1933 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order), provision was made for the administration of the Government of the territories known as the Protectorate of Nigeria:

And whereas it is expedient to make other provision in certain respects than in the 'said Orders is contained for the administration of the Government of the said Protectorate:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1890, or otherwise in His Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

I. This Order may be cited as the Nigeria Protectorate Order in Council, 1935, and shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.

II. Clauses V, XVIII, and XX of the Principal Order, and the Nigeria. Protectorate Order in Council, 1933, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything lawfully done thereunder and the following Clause is hereby substituted for Clause XX of the Principal Order:-

"XX. The Governor may, subject to such instructions as may from time to time be given to him by His Majesty through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, upon sufficient cause to him appearing, dismiss or suspend from the exercise of his office any person holding any public office within the Protectorate, or subject as aforesaid, may take such other disciplinary action as may seem to him desirable."

III. This Order shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor by Proclamation in the Nigeria Gazette, and shall be published in such Gazette; and the Governor shall give directions for the publication of this Order at such places, and in such manner, and for such time or times as he thinks proper for giving due publicity thereto within the Protectorate of Nigeria.

IV. His Majesty may from time to time revoke, alter, add to, or amend this Order.

And the Right Honourable Malcolm MacDonald, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, is to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
