ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930. ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.

COUNTY OF SOUTHAMPTON.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 29th January, 1936, the Minister of Transport modified and confirmed the County of Southampton Roads (Restriction) Order, 1934, made

by the County Council of Southampton on 30th July, 1934, under Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933. The Order as modified provides that:-

(1) Subject to certain exceptions, no personshall drive or cause to be driven any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor, or heavy motor car (as respectively defined in Section 2 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, or in any Regulations made thereunder) or any motor car (as defined as aforesaid) with seats for more than 7 persons exclusive of the driver, on the roads specified in Schedule I. hereto.

(2) Subject to certain exceptions, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor, or heavy motor car (as defined in Paragraph 1 above) or any motor car (as defined as aforesaid) with seats for more than 14 persons exclusive of the driver, on the roads specified

in Schedule II. hereto.

(3) Subject to certain exceptions, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor, or heavy motor car (as defined in Paragraph 1 above) or any motor car (as defined as aforesaid) with seats for more than 20 persons exclusive of the driver, on the roads specified in Schedule III. hereto.

(4) Nothing in the Order contained shall prevent the driving of any motor vehicle with seats for not more than 20 passengers which is being used for the conveyance of children to and from school on that part of the road specified under the heading of Rural Districts of Romsey and Stockbridge and Winchester in Schedule II. hereto which lies between its junction with Route A.31 and its junction with the road from Slackstead.

SCHEDULE I.

Rural District of Alton.

Road from its junction with the Headley-Grayshott Road quarter-mile East of Grayshott Hall to Waggoners Wells.

Rural District of Andover.

Cattle Lane from its junction with the Weyhill-Abbotts Ann Road near the Mill at Abbotts Ann to its junction with the Over Wallop-Andover Road (A.343) North of

Road from its junction with the Monxton-Hundred Acre Corner Road North of the Mill at Monxton, South-East to its junction with the Weyhill-Abbotts Ann Road near the Mill at Abbotts Ann.

Road from its junction with the Balksbury-Upper Clatford-Goodworth Clatford Road from a point 110 yards North of the "Crock and Shears" Inn at Upper Clatford North-East to the Andover Borough Boundary.
