#### RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

##### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, to make Regulations in regard to a system of "one-way" traffic working in White Lion Street, between Baron Street, Finsbury, and High Street (A.1), Islington, and a prohibition of the right hand turn from White Lion Street into High Street.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency, the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 11) Provisional Regulations, 1936, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations, and to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
