ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport, under and by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, intends to make the Road Traffic Act, 1934 (Directions under paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of Section 1) (No. 4) Order, 1936, the effect of which will be:—

(a) that there will be no speed limit under that Section in respect of either road specified in the First Schedule hereto; and

(b) that the speed limit under the said Section will apply throughout the roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
