

URBAN DISTRICT OF LONGRIDGE.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

By an Order dated the 13th day of March, 1936, the Minister of Health has declared that on and after the 11th day of May, 1936, the following provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Longridge, namely:—

Part II (Streets and Buildings) other than Sections 21 and 31;

Part III (Sanitary provisions);

Part IV (Infectious diseases) other than Section 68; and

Part V (Common Lodging-houses).

The above provisions are declared to be in force subject, as regards Sections 23, 25, 27, 30, 35, 38 and 75 to the conditions specified in the Order.

A copy of the Order may be inspected at the Council Offices, Market Place, Longridge, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

KIRKBURTON SHELLEY & SHEPLEY GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade forthwith by The Kirkburton Shelley & Shepley Gas Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") whose address is The Gas Works, Kirkburton in the County of York, for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934 for all or some of the following (amongst other) purposes (that is to say):—

1. To incorporate with the Order with or without modification or to render inapplicable all or some of the provisions of the Lands Clauses Acts, the Gasworks Clauses Act 1847 and the Gasworks Clauses Act 1871.

2. To settle the limits within which the Company shall be authorized to supply gas namely the Urban Districts of Kirkburton and Shepley and part of the parishes of Shelley Cumberworth Denby. Lepton Thurstonland and Farnley Tyas in the West Riding of the County of York being the areas in which the Kirkburton Gas Light Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Kirkburton Company") and the Shelley & Shepley Gas Light Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Shelley Company") are now authorized to supply gas.

3. To fix the date of coming into operation of the Order.

4. To authorize the transfer of the undertaking of the Kirkburton Company to the Company upon the terms of any agreement

which may have been entered into and to authorize the transfer of the undertaking of the Shelley Company to the Company upon the terms of any agreement which may have been entered into.

5. To fix the maximum ordinary and additional capital of the Company.

6. To make provisions as to the consideration for such transfers as to share capital to be issued to shareholders of the Kirkburton Company and the Shelley Company, as to trusts of substituted shares, as to exchange of certificates, as to outstanding transfers, as to evidence, as to receipts, for contracts to remain binding, as to non-abatement of actions and as to the debts and liabilities of and moneys due to or accruing due to the Kirkburton Company and the Shelley Company respectively.

7. To make provisions as to the sale of Shares of the Company by auction or tender and to empower the Directors of the Company to reserve a proportion of any issue of shares for exclusive offer to employees of the Company and to consumers of gas supplied by the Company and to make provisions as to the conditions of issue.

8. To empower the Company with the consent of the Board of Trade to offer shares for subscription by employees of the Company and by the consumers of gas supplied by the Company in lieu of offering the same for sale by auction or tender.

9. To limit the borrowing powers of the Company.

10. To make provisions as to the profits of the Company which may be divided among the shareholders of the Company and to fix a standard rate of dividend on the ordinary capital and to prescribe a maximum rate of interest on preference capital.

11. To limit interest payable on money borrowed by the Company.

12. To deal with application of capital moneys.

13. To empower the Company to maintain erect alter improve and renew gas works with all necessary machinery and apparatus and do all such acts as may be proper for making and storing gas and for supplying gas within the limits of supply. And also upon the lands hereinafter described to work up and convert residual products and to purchase and use material required to work up and convert residual products. The said lands are:—

1. A plot of ground situate in Kirkburton aforesaid containing by admeasurement 1 r. 77 p. or thereabouts. Bounded on or towards the Easterly side thereof by the highway leading from Penistone to Huddersfield on or towards the Westerly side thereof by Woodsome Beck on or towards the Northerly side thereof by the property secondly described in this Notice and on or towards the Southerly side thereof by the highway leading to Storthes Hall Lane.

2. A plot of land situate in Kirkburton aforesaid containing by admeasurement 2 r. 16 p. or thereabouts. Bounded on or towards the Easterly side thereof by the highway leading from Penistone to Huddersfield on or towards the Westerly side thereof partly by Woodsome Beck and partly by the land thirdly described in this Notice on or
