

Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, do by this present instrument under our Seal alter and amend and add to the Statutes of Saint John Baptist College Oxford in manner following, that is to say, by the addition of a new Statute as follows:—

STATUTE XXVI.

BLISS TRUST.

1. One half of each of the investments representing the Bliss Fund on the date of the approval of this Statute by His Majesty in Council shall be forthwith transferred (together with one half of the undistributed income (if any) of the Bliss Fund held by Saint John Baptist College at the date of such transfer) by Saint John Baptist College to Oriol College and shall be received by Oriol College.

2. As from the date of the said transfer Saint John Baptist College shall be released and discharged from the trust to pay over one half of the income of the Bliss Fund to Oriol College or St. Mary Hall and from all liability whatsoever in respect thereof.

3. Saint John Baptist College shall retain the remaining moiety of the Bliss Fund and shall apply the income thereof for the purposes mentioned in the Will of the Testator namely towards the augmentation of the Librarian's Place of the said College provided that such Librarian shall be resident in the said College for the space of six months at the least in each and every year computed from the 1st day of October in every year that he receives the augmentation but otherwise such income shall be expended in the purchase of books for the said Library.
