BOROUGH OF MANSFIELD.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907, AND THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

BY an order dated the 14th day of May 1936, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the 13th day of July 1936, the following provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, and the Public Health Act, 1925, shall be in force in the Borough of Mansfield namely:—

The Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907—

Sections 16, 17, 19, 20, 23, 25, 26, 28 and 29 (subject to the provisions of section 33) comprised in Part II (streets and buildings);

Sections 34, 36 to 45 (inclusive) 47 and 49 comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions);

Sections 52 to 59 (inclusive) 61, 62 and 65 to 67 (inclusive) comprised in Part IV (infectious diseases);

Part V (common lodging-houses); and

Part VI (recreation grounds).

The Public Health Act, 1925—

Part VI (recreation grounds):

The above provisions are declared to be in force subject, as regards sections 23, 38 and 75 of the Act of 1907 to the conditions specified in the order.

The Minister of Health has also repealed, as from the 13th day of July, 1936, certain provisions of the following local Acts, namely:—

Short Title.

Extent of repeal and subject-matter of provisions repealed.

The Mansfield Corporation Act, 1901.

Section 68 (retention of plans deposited with Corporation).

Section 72 (power to vary position or direction of new streets).

Section 73 (what to be deemed new buildings) except so far as it relates to the conversion of a dwelling-house into any other building not intended for human habitation.

Section 75 (yards to be paved).

Section 78 (injury to streets by excavation to be made good) so far as it relates to the footway of any street repairable by the inhabitants at large.

Section 80 (entrances to courts, etc., not to be closed, etc., without consent of Corporation).

Section 85 (Corporation may require water-closets or waste-water closets to new buildings).

Section 86 (if no sufficient closet accommodation Corporation may require water closet or waste-water closet).

Section 87 (conversion of existing closet accommodation into water closet or waste-water closet) except so far as it relates to receptacles for ashes and house refuse.

Section 88 (appeal under the two last preceding sections) except so far as it relates to receptacles for ashes and house refuse.

Section 89 (in case of closet accommodation to several houses).

Section 90 (apportionment of expenses in case of joint owners).

Section 93 (urinals to be attached to inns, etc.).

Section 94 (Corporation may require removal or alteration of urinals, etc.).

Section 96 (public conveniences and lavatories).

Section 97 (owners, etc., to permit application of test to drains).

Section 109 (dairymen to notify infectious disease existing among their servants, etc.).

Section 110 (medical officer may require dairymen to furnish list of sources of their supply of milk).
