LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of
Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order
under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming
the Order made on the 25th day of January,
1936, adding to Part I of the First Schedule
to the Act the area the drainage of which is
directed to the Scalby Sea Cut and, as from
the appointed day, combining the said area
with the River Ouse (Yorks) Catchment Area,
which Order has now come into force.

duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the
Order is not within the powers of the Act or
that the interests of the applicant have been
substantially prejudiced by any requirements
of the Act not having been complied with, may
quash the Order either generally or in so far as
it affects the applicant.
