

the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade forthwith by the Bath Gas Company (hereinafter called "the Company"), whose address is 18, Old Bond Street, Bath, for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

4. To make provision as to the consideration for such purchase and sale and as to the debts and liabilities of and moneys due or accruing due to the Vendors.
5. To make provision for the creation of consolidated ordinary stock of the Company to the amount requisite for the purpose of such purchase and sale and to define the ranking of the stock so created and the rights of the holders thereof.
6. To provide for the dissolution of the Vendors and the winding-up of their affairs.
7. To make provision as to the compensation to be paid by the Company to the directors officers and employees of the Vendors.
8. To extend the limits within which the Company are authorised to supply gas so as to include the following areas (hereinafter referred to as "the added limits") :—
(Areas within the limits of supply of the Vendors (hereinafter referred to as "the Frome Limits").)
