THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

BY an Order dated the 16th day of June, 1936, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the 7th day of July, 1936, the following provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Rural District of North Westmorland as hereinafter mentioned:—

(a) In the contributory places of Asby, Askham, Bampton, Barton, Bolton, Brougham, Cliburn, Clifton, Crosby Ravensworth, Great Strickland, Kings Meaburn, Little Strickland, Lowther, Martindale, Morland, Newby, Orton, Shap, Shap Rural, Sleagill, Sockbridge, Tebay, Thrimby, and Yanwath and Eamont Bridge:—

Sections 34, 35, 38 and 43 to 46 (inclusive) comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions);

(b) In the contributory places of Asby, Barton, Brougham, Cliburn, Crosby Ravensworth, Orton, Shap, Shap Rural, Sockbridge and Tebay:—

Section 50 comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions).

The above provisions are declared to be in force subject, as regards sections 35 and 38 to the conditions specified in the Order.

CHORLEY GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Chorley (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Hall, Chorley, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under and in pursuance of the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934 for all or some of the following, amongst other, purposes (that is to say):

1. To extend the limits within which the Corporation are authorised to supply gas by the addition thereto of:—

In the County of Lancaster:—

The Parish and Urban District of Adlington.

In the rural district of Chorley:—

So much of the parish of Anderton as comprises:—

(a) the area situate between the boundary of the Urban District of Adlington and Babylon Lane (on the north-westerly side).

(b) the area on the south-easterly side of and abutting on Babylon Lane which includes the houses and the lands appurtenant thereto numbered 3 to 25 (odd numbers inclusive) 51 to 91 (odd numbers inclusive) and 91A and the house and land appurtenant thereto called "Glendonwyne".

(c) the area forming the site of the premises numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, Green Street (off Babylon Lane) and the vacant land abutting on that street.

(d) the area situate on the north-easterly side of the boundary of the Urban District of Adlington between the last mentioned area (c) and St. Joseph's Roman Catholic School and lying to the south-east of such last mentioned area.

(e) the area fronting on Bolton Road which forms the site of St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church including the Presbytery the School and the Burial Ground attached thereto.

(f) the area forming the site of the premises numbered 2 to 16 (even numbers inclusive) Greenhalgh Lane and the lands appurtenant thereto.

and to authorise the Corporation to exercise within the area hereinbefore described all or some of the powers exercisable by them in respect of their gas undertaking in their existing limits of supply and to exclude from the limits for the supply of gas of the Blackrod Gas Company the part of the parish of Anderton above described as is within their existing limits.

2. To transfer to and vest in the Corporation the undertaking of the Adlington Gas Company Limited upon such terms and for such consideration as may be specified in the Order and to sanction and confirm the agreement entered into between the said Company and the Corporation relating to such transfer and vesting and to make such further provision incidental to and consequent on such transfer and vesting as may be contained in the Order.

3. To authorise the Corporation on and after the date on which the said transfer and vesting is completed to maintain continue alter improve use and renew gas works upon the following land:—

A parcel of land situate in the parish and urban district of Adlington in the County of Lancaster containing an area of 3,670 superficial square yards or thereabouts being the enclosure numbered 126 on the ¹/₂₅₀₀ Ordnance Map Lancashire Sheet LXXXV. 8 (1928 Edition) and bounded on the north and on the east by land belonging to the urban district council of Adlington on the south by Harrison Road (formerly called Smithy Field Lane) and on the west by the Lancaster Canal.

4. To make new or further provisions and confer further powers with reference to the Corporation's gas undertaking including provisions as to:—the supply of gas to premises in private streets and the laying of pipes for that purpose; the supply of gas to premises abutting on streets &c. forming the boundary of but outside the limits of supply and as to the breaking up of such streets for the purpose
