ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of
 Transport, under and by virtue of the pro-
 visions of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of
 Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, intends
 to make the Road Traffic Act, 1934 (Directions
 under paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of
 Section 1) (No.) Order, 1936, the effect of
 which will be—

(a) that there will be no speed limit under
 that Section in respect of any length of road
 specified in the First Schedule hereto; and

(b) that the speed limit under the said
 Section will apply throughout every length
 of road specified in the Second Schedule
 hereto.

CATTLE INDUSTRY (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) ACTS, 1934 AND 1935.
