#### TAMWORTH GAS (CAPITAL AND BORROWING POWERS) ORDER, 1936.

(Application for an Order under Section 1 of the Gas Undertakings Act, 1929.)

NOTICE is hereby given that the Tamworth Gaslight and Coke Company (hereinafter called "the Company"), whose address is the Gasworks, Tamworth, in the County of Stafford (intend to apply to the Board of Trade for an Order under Section 1 of the Gas Undertakings Act, 1929, for the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorise the Company to raise at any time during a period of three years after the date on which the Order comes into effect additional share capital not exceeding when added to the amount already authorised the sum of sixty thousand pounds.

2. To authorise the Company to borrow on mortgage of their undertaking or by the creation and issue of debenture stock any amount not exceeding sixty per centum of the aggregate amount of paid-up share capital of the undertaking for the time being, and of any premiums paid in respect thereof.

3. To modify the provisions of Section 9 of the Tamworth Gas Act, 1911 (1 and 2 Geo. 5, ch. xxxii), and to repeal or amend any other provisions of the Tamworth Gas Acts and Orders, 1872 to 1925, and any other Act or Order affecting the Company which may be necessary in order to give full effect to the proposed Order.

Any local or other public authority, company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to this application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 19th day of September, 1936.

Any such objection must state the specific grounds of objection and a copy of the objection must be forwarded to the under-mentioned Solicitor at the same time as it is sent to the Board of Trade.
