

PARISH MEETINGS (POLLS) RULES.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that on the 1st August, 1936, he made in pursuance of the Local Government Act, 1933 (23 and 24 Geo. 5, c. 51) Rules for the conduct of a poll consequent on a parish meeting, other than a poll for the election of parish councillors, and Regulations prescribing forms for use thereat.

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made Orders authorising the employment on two day-shifts of:—

(a) Male young persons over 16 years of age in the machine-shop at the works of The Parkfield Engineering Co., Ltd., Ellesmere Street, Farnworth, near Bolton, subject to conditions as to weekly alternation of shifts, accommodation for clothing, facilities for washing and for taking meals, and that transport facilities may be required.

(b) Women and young persons over 16 years of age in soap making, milling, packing and despatching at the works of The British Hygienics Ltd., Buckingham Avenue, Slough, subject to similar conditions.

(c) Women and young persons over 16 years of age in certain processes in the calendering, inner tube and stock preparation departments at the works of The Goodyear Tyre & Rubber Co. (Great Britain) Ltd., Stafford Road, Wolverhampton, subject to conditions similar to those under (a) and to a condition as to the provision of seats.
