COLONIAL STOCK ACTS, 1877 to 1934.

Addition to list of Stocks under Section 2 of the Colonial Stock Act, 1900. (63 and 64 Vic. cap. 62).

Pursuant to Section 2 of the Colonial Stock Act, 1900, the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that the provisions of the Act have been complied with in respect of the undermentioned Stock inscribed in the United Kingdom:—

Kenya Government 3 per cent. Inscribed Stock, 1956-1961.

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made Orders authorising the employment on two day-shifts of:—

(a) Women and young persons over 16 years of age in dry-cleaning, wet cleaning, dyeing, spotting, pressing, inspecting, packing and despatching at the works of Messrs. Walkers (Dyers & Cleaners) Ltd., Argall Avenue, Staffa Road, E.10, subject to conditions as to weekly alternation of shifts, accommodation for clothing, facilities for washing and for taking meals, and that transport facilities may be required.
