CITY OF NOTTINGHAM (BUILT-UP AREA) PLANNING SCHEME.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1932.

NOTICE is hereby given that (1) on the 27th day of August, 1936, the Minister of Health notified his approval of the resolution of the Council of the City of Nottingham dated the 4th day of May, 1936, deciding to prepare the above planning scheme with reference to an area situate in the City of Nottingham; (2) the Map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the Town Clerk's Office, the Guildhall, Nottingham, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without charge between the hours of 10 a.m. and noon, and 3 p.m. and 5 p.m., except on Saturdays and Sundays; (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area and any association representing owners of property within the City of Nottingham and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Nottingham City Council to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Nottingham City Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

URBAN DISTRICT OF MERTON AND MORDEN.

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL ACT, 1931—
SECTION 89.

Order as to land liable to Flooding.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Merton and Morden intend pursuant to the provisions of Section 89 of the Surrey County Council Act, 1931, to apply to the Minister of Health on or after the 9th October, 1936, for approval of an Order made by the Council declaring that the erection of any building intended or adapted for use as a dwellinghouse (other than a dwellinghouse which is to be occupied together with land which is or is to be used mainly or exclusively for agriculture, whether as arable, meadow, pasture ground or orchard, or for the purposes of a plantation or a wood or for the growth of saleable underwood) shall be prohibited on land edged green and hatched green on the plan attached to the Order and comprising parcels 189 (area 0.969 acres) 191 (area 24.259 acres) and 210 (area 0.992 acres) as numbered on the Surrey Sheet VII 15 of the 1913 Edition of the Ordnance Survey.

Copies of the Order can be obtained free of charge at the Office of the Council, at Dorset Hall, Kingston Road, Merton, S.W.19, where the Order will be open to public inspection without payment on any week-day during the usual office hours until Friday, 9th October, 1936. Any person aggrieved by the Order may make representations thereon to the Minister of Health by letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, London, S.W.1, not later than Friday, 9th October, 1936, and any such person shall at the same time send a copy of the representations to me at the address given below.
