The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts of male young persons over 16 years of age in dry cleaning and pressing at the factory of Messrs. Bollom of Bristol Limited, Horfield Road, Bristol 2, subject to conditions as to weekly alternation of shifts, the provision of protective clothing, accommodation for clothing and facilities for washing and for taking meals.
