RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, to make the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No.) (The Triangle, Kensington) Regulations, 1936, in regard to "roundabout" traffic working at the junction of The Triangle with St. Quintin Avenue and Highlever Road, Kensington, and the prohibition of the right-hand turn

(a) from Barlby Road into Highlever Road, Kensington, and

(b) from Highlever Road into St. Quintin Avenue, East of Highlever Road, Kensington.

These Regulations will revoke the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 21) (The Triangle, Kensington) Regulations, 1935.
