PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 37, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme bearing date the 23rd day of July, 1936, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 37, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for assigning the right of Patronage of the District of Saint George, East Ham, in the County of Essex and in the Diocese of Chelmsford:

“ Whereas by an Order of His late Majesty King George the Fifth in Council bearing date the 7th day of July, 1923, and published in the *London Gazette* on the 10th day of the same month the said District of Saint George, East Ham, was, under the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Act, constituted out of the Parish of East Ham, in the said County and Diocese:

“ And whereas no assignment of the Patronage of the said District of Saint George, East Ham, was made by the said Order and no such assignment has since been made:

“ And whereas a capital sum of £2,000 has been contributed and paid to the credit of our account at the Bank of England towards the cost of erecting a permanent Church for the said District of Saint George, East Ham:

“ And whereas the said capital sum of £2,000 has been so contributed and paid as aforesaid upon the understanding that (such arrangement appearing to us expedient) the whole right of Patronage of the said District of Saint George, East Ham, and when such District shall have become a New Parish, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof should be assigned in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed:

“ And whereas the contributors of the said capital sum of £2,000 have nominated to us the Bishop for the time being of the said Diocese of Chelmsford as the person to whom they desire that the Patronage and right of nomination and presentation of and to the said District or New Parish of Saint George, East Ham, should be assigned, and we are satisfied that the said assignment may properly be effected:

“ Now, therefore, we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said District of Saint George, East Ham, and when such District shall have become a New Parish as aforesaid, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof shall without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than this Scheme and any duly gazetted Order
