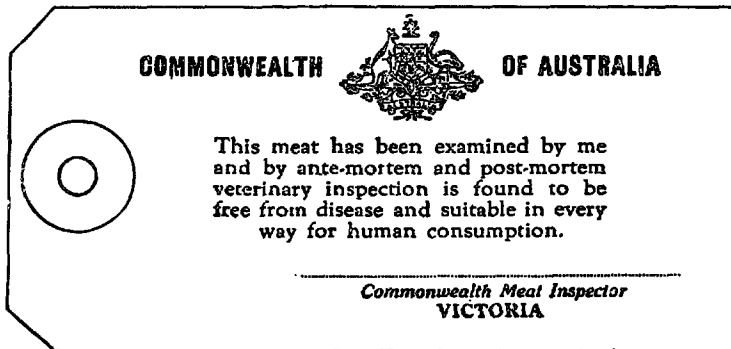


2. COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA.

SCHEDULE.

Contracted Infected Area.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Cornwall.

The city of Truro.

The petty sessional division of West Powder (except the parishes of St. Agnes, including its detached part, Chacewater, Feock, and so much of the parish of Ladock as lies to the north-east of the road running from Mitchell via Trellassick, Ladock Wood and Ladock to the Cross Roads about quarter of a mile north of Grampound Road Station and thence in a southerly direction to the Station).

The parish of St. Michael Penkevil; so much of the parish of Probus as lies to the west of the road running from Grampound Road Station via Trewithen and Grogoth Wartha to Cornelly; and so much of the parish of Newlyn:
