The following Statutes made by the University of Cambridge, on the 28th day of November, 1936, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

STATUTES to alter and amend the Statutes in relation to the University of Cambridge, made under "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923" (13 & 14 George V, Chapter 33), which amending Statutes are now submitted for the approval of His Majesty The King in Council.

We, The Chancellor, Masters, and Scholars of the University of Cambridge, in pursuance of the power given to us by the 7th Section of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, do hereby alter and amend the Statutes made under that Act in relation to our said University in manner following, that is to say:

STATUTE D.

CHAPTER IX.

THE TREASURER.

By adding the following clause to Section 1:

(g) to sign contracts and agreements made by the Financial Board in the exercise of

their powers and duties under the Statute intituled Finance and Property except in so far as such contracts and agreements require to be sealed with the Common Seal of the University.

CHAPTER XII.

THE UNIVERSITY TEACHING OFFICERS.

By substituting in Section 5 for the words "any term during which the officer has held a University teaching office" the words "any term during which the officer has held either a University teaching office, or a Faculty Assistant Lectureship from which he passed without interval into a University teaching office".

STATUTE E.

TRUST EMOLUMENTS.

By adding the following Chapter:

CHAPTER XXXIX.

THE CROTCH FUND.

1. The investments from time to time representing the endowments given to the University under the will of George Robert Crotch dated 22 June 1872 and the will of William Duppa Duppa Crotch dated 15 August 1903 shall together constitute a trust fund called the Crotch Fund.

2. The income of the Crotch Fund shall be used for the purchase of books and specimens for the Museum of Zoology or otherwise for the general purposes of that Museum as may be provided by Ordinance.
