BUCKS WATER.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to Parliament in the Session 1936-37 by the County Council of the Administrative County of Buckingham for an Act under the above name or short title, the full title of which is "A Bill to constitute a Joint Board consisting of representatives of the County Council of the administrative County of Buckingham and the Rural District Councils of Aylesbury Buckingham Wing and Winslow; to vest in the said Board the water undertakings of certain of the constituent authorities; to authorise the Board to execute works and to supply water and for other purposes."
