

In Parliament.—Session 1936-37.

WHITLEY AND MONKSEATON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to Parliament in the present Session by the Urban District Council of Whitley and Monkseaton for an Act under the above name or short title, the title of which is "A Bill to empower the Urban District Council of Whitley and Monkseaton to construct a sea wall and other works; to acquire lands; to make further and better provision for the improvement health local government and finance of the district; and for other purposes."

In accordance with the Standing Orders of Parliament a notice containing a concise summary of the purposes of the Bill has been or will be published in the "Whitley Seaside Chronicle and Visitors Gazette" on the 4th and 11th December, 1936.

Plans and sections of the proposed works and plans of the lands to be acquired under the authority of the intended Act, together with a book of reference to the plans, were on or before the 20th day of November, 1936, deposited for public inspection with the Clerk to the County Council of the Administrative

County of Northumberland at his office at Newcastle-upon-Tyne and on or before the same date a copy of so much of the said plans, sections and book of reference as relates to each of the areas hereinafter mentioned were also deposited for public inspection as follows:—

As relates to the Borough of Blyth with the Town Clerk of the Borough of Blyth at Municipal Buildings, Seaforth Street, Blyth.
