FOWL PEST ORDER OF 1936.

SUBJECT.

Makes it obligatory for all cases or suspected cases of fowl pest to be notified to the Ministry's Veterinary Laboratory, New Haw, Weybridge, Surrey; Prescribes the precautions Mouth Diseato be adopted on premises on which disease is Order of 1925.

suspected and the Rules to be observed on Infected Places; Provides for payment of compensation for poultry, other than poultry affected with fowl pest, slaughtered under the Order; Requires cleansing and disinfection of premises, vehicles, utensils, appliances, etc., where there has been any poultry or carcase affected with or suspected of fowl pest; and Provides for the imposition of restrictions on movement of poultry exposed to infection.

POULTRY AND HATCHING EGGS (IMPORTATION) ORDER OF 1936.

SUBJECT.

Prohibits the importation into Great Britain except under prescribed conditions, of (i) domestic fowls, turkeys, geese and ducks; (ii) day-old chicks of domestic fowls; and (iii) the eggs of domestic fowls intended for hatching.

POULTRY MARKETS AND RECEPTACLES (DISINFECTION) ORDER OF 1936.

SUBJECT.

Requires the cleansing and disinfection, in the manner prescribed, of

(a) pens or other enclosures, benches, stands and other fittings, used for poultry in any market, fairground, saleyard, highway or other premises where live poultry are habitually exposed for sale, as soon as practicable after being used for that purpose and before being again so used; and

(b) receptacles used for the conveyance of
poultry to any place in Great Britain or for
the exposure for sale of poultry, as soon as
practicable after each load of poultry has
been removed and before being again used
for poultry or before being returned empty
