WHEREAS the Minister of Health, after giving 10 days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has, under the provisions of the Burial Act, 1853, as amended by subsequent enactments, made a Representation to His Majesty in Council that for the protection of the Public Health, the opening of any new burial ground in the County Borough of Southampton, save with the previous approval of the Minister of Health, should be prohibited, and that burials should be discontinued therein as follows, viz.:—

Southampton.—Forthwith and entirely in the Millbrook Church Burial Ground.

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give Notice of such Representation and to order that the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on the 6th day of February next.
