FACTORY AND WORKSHOP: FIRST AID.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by Section 79 of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, and Section 7 of the Police, Factories, etc. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1916, he proposes to amend certain Regulations and Welfare Orders so far as they relate to the marking of first aid boxes and cupboards at factories, workshops, docks and premises where machinery is used for the purpose of building operations.
