THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT, 1868.

THE GOVERNING BODY OF RUGBY SCHOOL having, on the 9th day of February, 1937, in virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the above-named Act, made a Statute in the terms appended hereto amending the existing Statutes of the said School, the said Statute is hereby published in the London Gazette in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in the said Act.

And Notice is hereby given, that any person, body of persons, or body corporate, authorized in that behalf by the said Act, may, within two months after the publication of this notification, petition His Majesty in Council to withhold His approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

STATUTE made by the Governing Body of Rugby School on the 9th day of February, 1937.

That the following alterations be made to the Statutes, namely:—

In place of Statutes XXVIII to XXXVII inclusive, which are repealed, insert the following:—

The Exhibitioners.

XXVIII.

Examinations shall be held once a year for the selection of Exhibitioners by competition. The Examinations shall be conducted by Examiners to be named or approved by the Governing Body in such subjects and in such manner as shall be determined by Regulation.

XXIX.

All boys in the Sixth Form who shall have been members of the School for not less than three years, including the Term in which the Examinations are held, shall be eligible for Exhibitions.

XXX.

The number of Exhibitions to be awarded in any one year shall not exceed eight.

XXXI.

The amount of each Exhibition shall be £30 a year, which sum shall be paid out of the Income of the School, unless the Governing Body, having regard to the said Income, shall see fit to alter this amount.

XXXII

If at the request of any Exhibitioner the Exhibition awarded is not paid to him, it shall be paid into a Fund to be called "The Leaving Exhibitions Augmentation Fund", to which Fund shall also be paid from the Income of the School the sum of £360 a year, or such greater or less amount as the Governing Body shall from time to time determine. This Fund shall be at the disposal of the Governing Body for the purpose of augmenting any Exhibition or Exhibitions by such amount as the circumstances of any Exhibitioner may, in the opinion of the Governing Body, require; provided that the total emoluments of any Exhibitioner shall not exceed such an amount as the Governing Body may from time to time determine by Regulation.
