the Order) and in pursuance of the Gas Regulation Act 1920 for the following purposes:—

(a) To extend the limits of supply of the Company to the parishes mentioned above and to fix the price of gas in such added limits.

(b) For raising additional capital.

(c) For appropriation to a renewal fund.

Copies of the Draft Special Order, together with copies of the Ordnance Map, on a scale of one inch to the mile, showing the situation of the existing Works, and of the area in which the Company are already authorised to supply gas and the proposed new area of supply have been deposited for public inspection at the Company's Office at 43 Regent Street, Swindon, at the Office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Wilts, at Trowbridge, at the Office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Berks, at Reading, and at the Office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Gloucester, at Gloucester.

ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 10th February, 1937, the Minister of Transport modified and confirmed the City of Sheffield Roads (Restriction) Order, 1936, made by the Sheffield City Council under Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933. The Order as modified and confirmed provides that subject to certain exceptions no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on that part of the road known as Carr Bank Lane in the City of Sheffield which lies between Fulwood Road and a point 260 yards to the east of Fulwood Road.
