Nazing Award.

Roydon Award.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made Orders under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the Orders made on the 18th March, 1937, in relation to the Schemes prepared by the Lee Conservancy Catchment Board, under Section 8 of the Act, for revoking certain of the provisions of an Award made on the 13th June, 1861 and confirmed on the 20th June, 1861, in relation to the Nazing Drain, and of the Roydon Award made on the 15th March, 1860 and confirmed on the 26th July, 1860.

Copies of the Orders may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Offices of the Lee Conservancy Catchment Board, Brettenham House, Lancaster Place, Strand, W.C.2, and also at the Offices of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, 10, Whitehall Place, London, S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
