

means of prepayment meters and the hire of such meters and fittings used therewith; the recovery of sums due for gas fittings, etc., and the cutting off of supplies of gas where charges are not wholly paid; to authorise charges for special readings of meters; to enable the Corporation to prevent the improper use of gas and to compel gas consumers to repair gas apparatus in cases of danger; to enact provisions relieving the Corporation from obligation to supply gas in such circumstances as may be defined in the Order except on the conditions set forth therein; to authorise the Corporation to purchase and use materials for working up and converting residual products arising from the manufacture of gas; and to empower the Corporation to take licences for use of patents.

7. To empower the Corporation to borrow money for the purchase of gas fittings and apparatus and for the payment of the costs charges and expenses of the Order, and to enact other financial provisions in respect of the gas undertaking of the Corporation, including provisions authorising the payment into and out of the general rate fund of all moneys received by the Corporation in respect of that undertaking; and requiring the keeping of separate accounts; the application of the revenue of the undertaking; the establishment of a reserve fund; and the use of moneys forming part of sinking and reserve funds in connection with the said undertaking for the purpose of any borrowing power exercisable by the Corporation in connection with that undertaking.

8. To make further provision with reference to the service of gas demand notes; the inclusion of several sums in one summons; and the recovery of demands and penalties.

9. To enable the Corporation to exercise all such powers as may be necessary or convenient for giving effect to the purposes of the Order, and to confer upon them all such other powers as are now usually conferred upon local authorities in connection with the supply of gas.

10. To vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with the objects of the Order and to confer other rights, powers and privileges.

11. To incorporate and apply with or without modification all or some of the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1871, the Public Health Act, 1875, the Arbitration Acts, 1889 to 1934, and the Local Government Act, 1933, and the Acts amending those Acts respectively, and to repeal, alter, amend, or reenact all or any of the provisions of the Retford Gas Order, 1874, and the East Retford Borough Act, 1878, and any other Act or Order relating to the Gas Undertaking of the Corporation.

Any local or other public authority, company, or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the eleventh day of June, 1937.

Any such objection shall state:—

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must be forwarded to the undermentioned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agents at the same time as it is sent to the Board of Trade.

Printed copies of the draft Order together with copies of an ordnance map on a scale of not less than one inch to the mile showing the situation of the existing gasworks of the Corporation and the boundaries of the added limits and of the area in which the Corporation are already authorised to supply gas have been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the undermentioned Town Clerk in the Municipal Buildings, The Square, Retford, and with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Nottingham, at his office at the Shire Hall, Nottingham.

Printed copies of the draft Order may be obtained at the offices of the undermentioned Town Clerk at the address aforesaid and at the offices of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents at a price not exceeding one shilling a copy.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930—PART V.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City and County Borough of Leeds (hereinafter called "the Council") have applied to the Traffic Commissioners for the Yorkshire Area for their consent to the running by the Council as part of their Omnibus Undertaking of Public Service Vehicles on the following route, namely:—

Commencing at the boundary of the City of Leeds in Broadway, Horsforth, and thence along Broadway to the junction of Broadway and Leeds and Guisley Road, numbered by the Minister of Transport A.65 all which said route lies within the Urban District of Horsforth.

Any objection to the said application by any Local Authority, County Council, or any persons who are already providing transport facilities on or in the neighbourhood of any part of the route to which the said application relates, may be made to the Traffic Commissioners at No. 44 The Headrow, Leeds 1, on or before the 31st day of May, 1937.

Any such objection should be in writing and should clearly state the grounds of such objection.
