THE CUMBERLAND DISTRICT (COAL MINES) SCHEME, 1930.

Whereas in pursuance of Clause 18 of the Cumberland District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, an amendment of the said Scheme as set out in the Schedule hereto has been submitted to the Board of Trade by the Executive Board elected under the provisions of the said Scheme:
