

## SUMMARY.

## REFRACTORY BRICKS.

With reference to the notices which were published in certain issues of the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes regarding references made by the Board of Trade to the Standing Committee appointed by them under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, namely:—

(1) in the issue of the said Gazettes of the 15th January, 1937, in respect of imported picture and greeting postcards, including those in sheets or reels,

(2) in the issue of the said Gazettes of the 12th February, 1937, in respect of the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) Exemption Direction (No. 1) 1937, relating to refractory bricks, blocks and tiles,

the Board of Trade hereby give notice in accordance with the provisions of Section 2, sub-section (7), that Reports have been made by the Committee in respect of the aforesaid classes and descriptions of goods.

## COAL MINES ACT, 1930.

## THE NORTH STAFFORDSHIRE DISTRICT (COAL MINES) SCHEME, 1930.

Whereas in pursuance of Clause 33 of the North Staffordshire District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, amendments of the said Scheme as set out in the Schedule hereto have been submitted to the Board of Trade by the Executive Board elected under the provisions of the said Scheme:

Now therefore the Board of Trade, under the provisions of the said Clause and of subsection (5) of Section I. of the Coal Mines Act, 1930, hereby approve the said amendments and prescribe the 31st day of May, 1937, as the date from which the said amendments shall come into force.

## SCHEDULE.

The North Staffordshire District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, shall be amended in the following manner:—

1. Clause 13 shall have effect as if—

(a) in sub-clause (1) for the words "The first appointment" to the end of the sub-clause there were substituted the words "The Board may appoint for each member of the Sales Committee (except the Independent Chairman) a person to act in case of need as a substitute for such member, and in the event of any member of the Committee being unavoidably prevented from attending any meeting of the Committee his substitute so appointed may attend and take part in the meeting in place of such member"; and

(b) in sub-clause (2) after the word "members" where that word occurs for the second time there were inserted the words "and substitute members".

2. Clause 52 shall have effect as if in sub-clause (1) after the words "may issue" there were inserted the words "at the request of an owner or otherwise".
