BASINGSTOKE GAS.

Application for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Basingstoke Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") whose Chief Office is situate at Victoria Road Aldershot in the County of Southampton intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934 for all or some of the following purposes, that is to say:—

1. To alter the prescribed number of directors of the Company and to make new provisions as to the quorum of a meeting of directors.

2. To make provision for the appointment by the directors of the Company of a managing director or managing directors and to provide that a managing director shall not be subject to retirement by rotation; to empower the directors to fix the remuneration of a managing director and to make provision as to the powers to be entrusted to and conferred upon a managing director.

3. To confer upon the Company or to enact such other provisions as may be deemed expedient for effecting the purposes of the intended Order.

To incorporate with the intended Order all or some of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845 and to amend or repeal any of the provisions of the Basingstoke Gas Acts and Orders 1887 to 1927 which may be inconsistent with the provisions of the intended Order.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 12th day of July, 1937. Any such objection must state (a) the specific grounds of objection and (b) the

omissions additions and modifications asked for and a copy thereof must at the same time be forwarded to the undermentioned Solicitor or Parliamentary Agents.

A copy of the draft Order has been deposited for public inspection at the Chief Office of the Company, Victoria Road, Aldershot, at the Office of the Company, 13, Church Street, Basingstoke, and at the Office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Southampton at Winchester.
